

## Troubleshooting - elna 664

| Condition                             | Cause   |  |
|---------------------------------------|---|--|
| The fabric is not being fed smoothly. | <ol> <li>The feed dog is packed with lint.</li> <li>The presser foot has been raised.</li> </ol>  | Lower the presser foot.                      |
| The needle breaks.                    | <ol> <li>The needle is incorrectly inserted.</li> <li>The needle is bent or blunt.</li> <li>The fabric is pulled strongly.</li> </ol>   | Replace the needle. Pull the fabric lightly. |
| The thread breaks.                    | <ol> <li>The machine is not correctly threaded.</li> <li>The needle or looper thread tension is too tight.</li> <li>The needle is incorrectly inserted.</li> <li>The needle is bent or blunt.</li> </ol>  | Replace the needle.                          |
| Skipped stitches                      | <ol> <li>The needle is bent or blunt.</li> <li>The machine is not correctly threaded.</li> <li>The needle is incorrectly inserted.</li> </ol>   | Replace the needle.                          |
| The seam is not sewn neatly.          | <ol> <li>The needle and/or looper thread tensions are not correctly adjusted.</li> <li>The machine is not correctly threaded.</li> <li>The stitch is not suitable for the fabric being sewn.</li> <li>The thread is not between the tension discs.</li> </ol> |  |
| Seam puckering                        | <ol> <li>The needle or looper thread tension is too tight.</li> <li>The machine is not correctly threaded.</li> <li>The differential feed dial is not correctly adjusted.</li> </ol>  |  |
| The machine does not operate.         | <ol> <li>The machine has not been plugged in firmly.</li> <li>The power switch is turned off.</li> </ol>  |  |
| The fabric is not cut neatly.         | <ol> <li>The position of the upper knife is not adjusted properly.</li> <li>The upper knife is dull.</li> </ol>   | Replace the upper knife.                     |
